

## OBOE REPAIR PRICING GUIDE

REPAIR TYPE	DESCRIPTION	COST
Tenon Cork (Oboe or EH)	Remove old tenon (joint) cork and adhesive. Replace with natural sheet cork. Fit for easy assembly/disassembly.	\$25 for one tenon cork. \$15 for each additional tenon cork.
EH Bocal Cork	Remove old cork and adhesive from bocal. Replace with natural sheet cork. Fit for easy assembly/disassembly.	\$30
Pad Replacement (Oboe or EH)	Necessary keys are disassembled. The old pad(s) and adhesive are removed and replaced with new cork pad(s). Pad(s) are then seated and instrument is adjusted to like-new playing condition. Includes basic adjustment.	\$35 for one pad. \$10 for each additional pad. (Bumper corks \$5 each)
Basic Repair (Oboe or EH)	Instrument is examined and put into good playing condition. Includes basic adjustment. Does not include pad or cork replacement. Major repair cost TBD.	\$50 and up
Basic Adjustment (Oboe or EH)	Instrument is examined. Pads and keys are tested for proper height, tension, and sealing. Instrument is adjusted to like-new playing condition. There will be no oiling, cleaning, re-corking, or re-padding.	\$10
Professional Adjustment (Oboe or EH)	Instrument is completely disassembled. All necessary bumper corks are removed and replaced. Bent keys are straightened and all keys are hand polished. Pads, corks, and tone-holes are cleaned. The body of the instrument is checked for cracks, then cleaned, oiled, and polished. Rods and screws are oiled and the instrument is reassembled. Pads and keys are tested for proper height, tension, and sealing. The instrument is adjusted to like-new playing condition.  Includes up to 3 pad replacements, 1 tenon cork replacement, and minor crack repair.	\$350 for oboe \$425 for EH
